

DDU varsity launches placement website

GORAKHPUR: Deen Dayal Upadhyay Gorakhpur University vice chancellor P.C. Trivedi launched a job placement website for students of the university here on Monday.

The prospective employers would be able to search for candidates on the website www.ddugonline.in.

The website has two parts. The first, employer zone, will

enable the companies to register themselves. The second is where the students would have to register and upload their resume.

The university administration would authenticate information about the employers and students.

The website would also display placement statistics of the university, the annual progress report, details of various facilities and courses.

placement/ employment bureau and guidance cell started this project for the university as part of a joint ven-

ture by the centre and the state government. Omni-NET technologies private limited developed the software for the website. Its managing director Ajey Kumar Gupta said, "Employers would select the required students and send the list to the university administration. A training placement officer would act as a bridge between students and employers. He would inform the students through mail or sms about interviews. Once a student is selected, he will

receive a message about job confirmation."

Students may talk to the employer through video-conferencing or online interface.

Trivedi said, "It is a great achievement for the university. Our university is a talent bank. But the students were not getting opportunities so far. Earlier, students had to search for jobs. Now, jobs would search for them."
